

What do parents THINK and FEEL?

- Isolated and no one is on their side
- Overwhelmed
- Excluded
- Intimidated
- Judged

What do parents <u>SEE</u> and <u>HEAR</u>?

- Resource/police officer
- No good calls, all bad ones
- Staff complaining
- Condescending language/actions
 - Parents hear: "I can take care of your kid, I don't need your help."

What are parents SAYING and DOING?

- "You don't know my kid"
- "I've been trying to reach somebody for days"
- "Leave me alone"

What do parents WANT?

- What is best for their child!
- Success
- Safety
- Validation
 - That their concerns are be taken seriously
 - That their child is being cared for

What can we do to remove barriers?

- Communicate!
- Start off on the right foot
- Promote a positive and accepting school climate
